Minitube is a native YouTube client. With it you can watch YouTube videos in a new way: you type a keyword, Minitube gives you an endless video stream. **Now adds channel subscriptions.**

Minitube does not require the *Flash Player*.

Minitube is not about cloning the original Youtube web interface, it strives to create a new TV-like experience.

Minitube is in its early stages. It lacks many features I planned for it. That said, it works.

What's new?

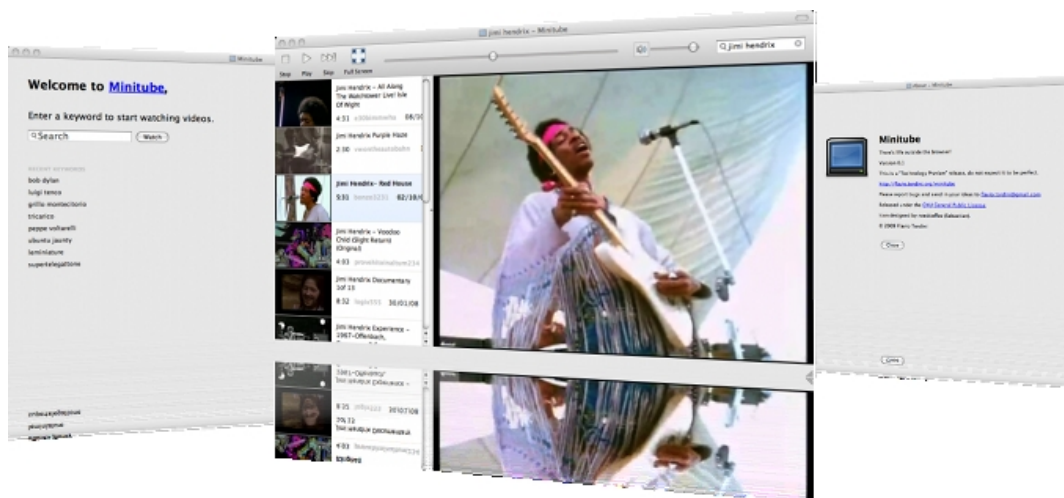
You can now subscribe to YouTube channels and be notified of new videos. This does not require a YouTube account. It's all done by **Minitube**.

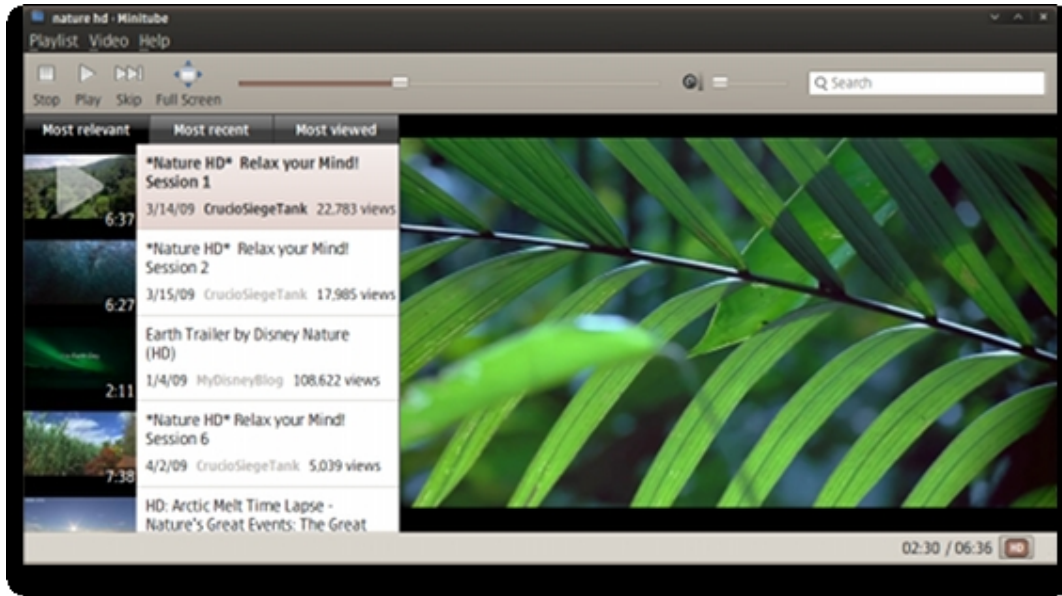
This release also restores playback of VEVO videos that stopped working a few days ago.

Other minor changes include:

- Move window by dragging from inside the video area
- Faster startup
- Optimizations and tweaks to the playlist
- Float on top icon was missing on Mac & Windows
- Compact mode window fixed aspect ratio on Mac
- Ubuntu notifications
- Fixed compact mode video cropped with very small window
- Fixed long words or URLs in the video description causing a window resize
- Fixed crash when resizing the playlist to a very small width
- Fixed skipping to the next video on Windows & Linux
